As a Member of STAR Health, you have access to:

As a FFCHE Member:

- You will not have Health Passport. The Health Passport is a health record that gives your doctors information about the care you receive outside of their office. You can go to page 6 in the Member handbook for more information.

PLEASE REMEMBER: If you are a FFCHE Member who is pregnant or if you become pregnant while in this program, your baby will NOT receive Medicaid. You must apply for Medicaid for your baby as soon as your baby is born. If you do not, your baby will not have Medicaid benefits.
