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Health Passport Overview

Superior HealthPlan's Health Passport is a web-based, secure health information tool built using core clinical and claims information to deliver relevant health-care information when and where it is needed for the children in foster care who are enrolled in STAR Health.

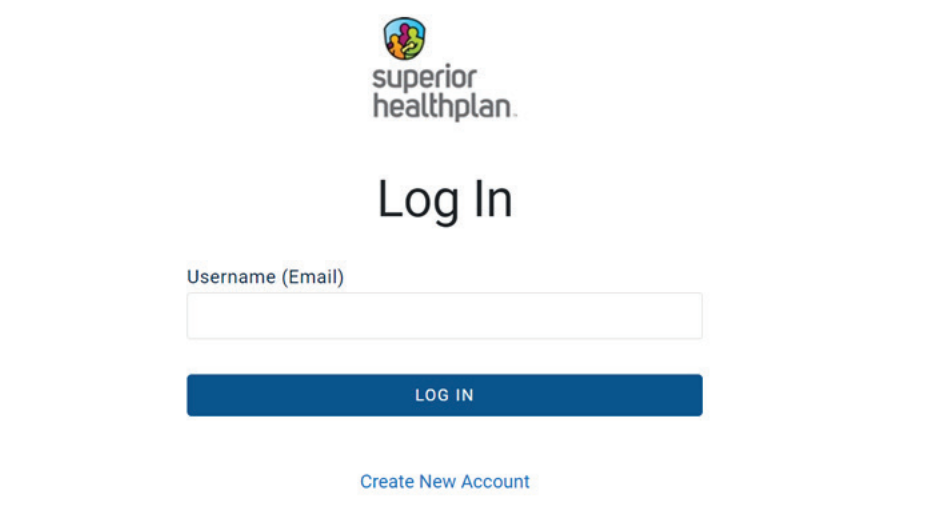
REMINDER: The data in the Health Passport is not a member's complete medical record, but it does contain information on member demographics, including doctor visits for which claims have been submitted, allergies, lab test results, immunizations and filled medications. Health Passport features include, but are not limited to:

-  **Face Sheet** - Access an easy-to-read summary that includes member demographics, care gaps, Texas Health Steps, Dental, Texas CANS 2.0-Assessment (last visit dates), active allergies, active medications and more.
-  **Contacts** - Find a patient's PCP, Medical Consenter, Caregiver, Caseworker assigned, and Service Coordinator's contact information in one place.
-  **Allergies** - View allergies that are available at the point-of-care. Once an allergy is charted, it is instantly checked for medication interactions.
-  **Assessments** - Upload and view documents including, but not limited to Texas Health Steps, Dental and Behavioral Health online. Documents that have submitted via fax or mail are also accessible online.
-  **Growth Chart** - View the weight, height, length, and head circumference that are available at the point of care to track growth of infants and children.
-  **Immunizations** - Access a comprehensive list of a member's immunizations collected from ImmTrac.
-  **Labs** - Access member's lab results in one location.
-  **Medical History** - A summary of medications filled is accessible. This includes name of the prescription, prescribing clinician, date filled and dosage. Indicators representing drug-drug, drug-allergy, and drug-food interactions appear when applicable as soon as new medications or allergies are added to the member record.
-  **Patient History** - Past visits with details that include the description of service, treating provider, diagnosis, and the service date.
-  **ADT Notifications Module** - Access Admit Discharge and Transfer (ADT) data.
-  **Appointments** - All users can review and add appointments for members.

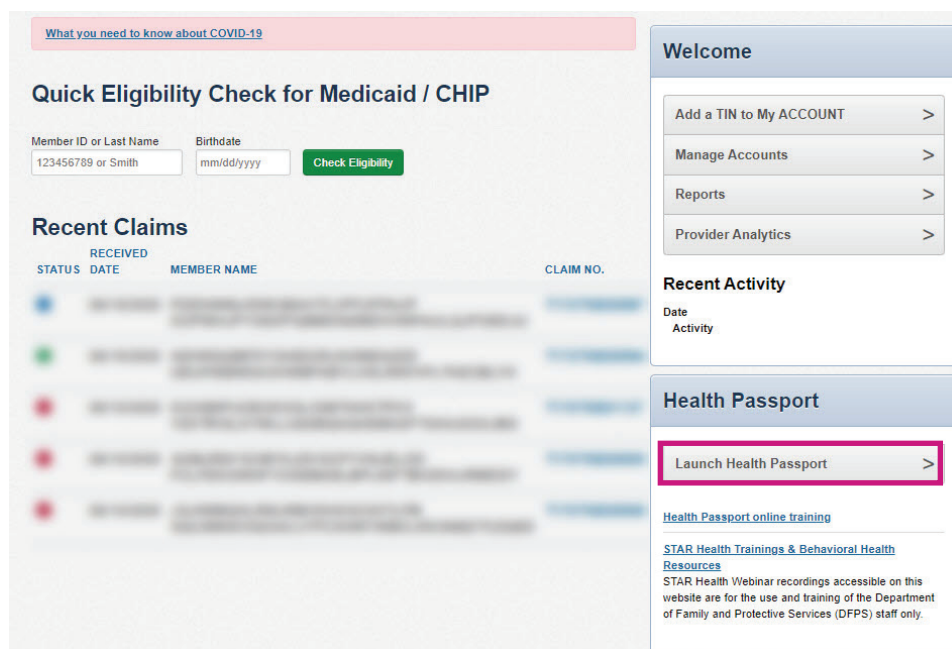
Provider Access

Providers can access the Health Passport secure web application by following the instructions below:

- Visit superiorhealthplan.entrykeyid.com using Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge.
- To log in, enter the **User Name (Email)** and **Password** you created during registration, then click **Login**. If you need to create an account, click the **Create an Account** button to register.
- Once you have logged in or created an account, you can access Health Passport by selecting the **Launch Health Passport** button from your account homepage.

- The User Agreement and Disclaimer will appear. Once you have read the agreement, click **I have read and agree to these terms** to continue.

User Agreement for Persons Other than Health Care Providers

Authorized users who are not health care providers (such as Medical Consenters, authorized DFPS and HHSC employees, and designated residential provider staff) agree to treat all information contained within a Health Passport record as confidential.

Terms of the Agreement

If you access, view, copy, download or otherwise use a Health Passport record, you agree:

- Not to share information from the Health Passport with anyone without a direct need to know the information for purposes of providing health care services, including behavioral health care services, to the Foster Child.
- To share only the minimum amount of information from the Health Passport as is necessary to aid in the provision of health care services, including behavioral health care services, to the Foster Child.
- To be responsible for maintaining the physical security and confidentiality of Health Passport information that you may view on a computer, print to paper, or copy or download to other formats. People who do not need the information should not have physical access to it. You must not leave the Health Passport site open on your computer screen when you walk away from your computer. Information on the Health Passport should be treated with the same concern for security and privacy as you give your financial papers or other private, personal information.
- To be responsible for complying with all applicable state and federal laws, including privacy laws, and to report any non-compliance that you may notice on the part of others within your organization. Passwords must not be shared. All users must create and manage their own accounts.
- To limit your access to Health Passport records to those Foster Children who are served by your organization or with whom you have a relationship for which Health Passport access is authorized. Not to share your password. If you are aware that a password has been shared, you are required to notify Superior HealthPlan Network within 24 hours so that a new password can be assigned.

Superior HealthPlan Network reserve the right to monitor all activity on the website.

By using the services provided by this website, you agree to the above terms. If you do not agree to be bound by this agreement, you are not authorized to enter this website and may not use any of the services available through this website.

Disclaimer

All Users

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As long as a patient has active coverage in Superior HealthPlan's STAR Health Foster Care Program, the patient's information will remain available through the Health Passport. If a patient's enrollment in the program terminates, the patient's Health Passport record will be archived and will be unavailable for viewing.

What is this drug used for?

- It is used to treat skin infections.

What do I need to tell my doctor BEFORE I take this drug?

- If you have an allergy to mupirocin or any other part of this drug.
- If you are allergic to any drugs like this one, any other drugs, foods, or other substances. Tell your doctor about the allergy and what signs you had, like rash; hives; itching; shortness of breath; wheezing; cough; swelling of face, lips, tongue, or throat; or any other signs.
- If a large area needs to be treated.
- If your skin is damaged or has open wounds. Do not put on damaged skin or open wounds.

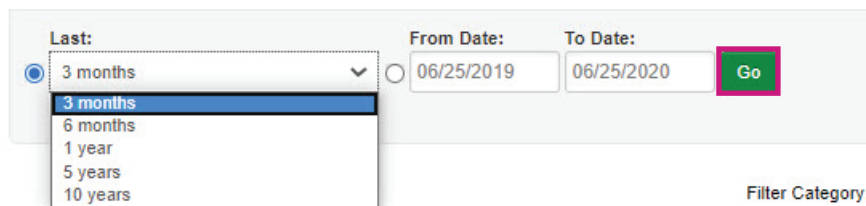
